

ONLINE SUMMER COURSE

LSC 560: Scientific Writing

June 14 - July 18



A five-week online course focused on clear and effective science writing strategies which are critical to successfully communicating science in an increasingly interdisciplinary research environment.

This course is open to UW-Madison students in the physical, biological, and social sciences in addition to working scientists and other science professionals.

FOR STUDENTS: This course provides training in writing and communicating to scientific audiences in preparation for a career in science and research.

FOR PROFESSIONALS: This course is an excellent professional development opportunity where professionals anywhere in the world can hone their skills and learn techniques to communicate more effectively with colleagues in the scientific community.

Build skills in four key areas:

- Argue persuasively for why research is important and needed.
- Use elements of story to engage scientific audiences and structure written and oral communications.
- Produce writing that is clear, compelling, and enjoyable to read.
- Give and receive feedback on writing.
